



## Online Privacy (Teacher's notes)

Age: KS 2/3

Timing: Approx 35 mins

The following sets of cards can be photocopied and used to generate discussion in class groups. The topic looks at what it is safe to disclose in an online environment. Ask pupils to take 2 sheets of paper and write "Private" on one and "Not Private" on the other.

**Using these 2 sets of information below, ask the class to divide the information choices as they feel appropriate.**

Use the responses to the information as a lead into discussion on face to face communication versus other methods of communication. Use these conversations to reinforce the unreliable nature of online chatroom environments and the possibility of people not being exactly who they say they are in an online setting.
